Discussion Questions (Deborah)

#1 What leadership roles do you hold (wife, mother, grandmother, employer, teacher, coach, Bible study leader, mentor, etc.)? Do you tend to lead out of God's will and plan or out of your own ambitions? If you don't feel equipped, do you truly believe He will grow you and give you what you need to follow His will?

#2 Do you submit to (respect) and support godly leadership in your life, especially the men (father, husband, boss, pastor)? If you struggle with this concept, study more about what the Bible has to say about gender roles (Genesis 1&2, Proverbs 31, 1 Timothy 2) to see why God's way is the best way.

Discussion Questions (Miriam)

#1 How does looking at Miriam's whole story help you understand her? How does it help you understand that a Christian's identity comes from God and not from our performance?

#2 Which season of Miriam's life can you relate to right now (Courageous, needing humility, facing consequences)?

Discussion Questions (Hemorrhaging Woman)

#1 Are you ready to have a tender encounter with Jesus? Are you willing to run to Him and press in for your healing, or are you trying to do it on your own? Discuss the reasons that hold us back from surrendering all.

#2 Do you recognize the gift of faith God has given you or are you relying on yourself? Discuss ways your faith can be strengthened by investing in your relationship with Jesus. (**See**, Jeremiah 29:11-14; Luke 11:10; John 15:7)

Discussion Questions (Mary of Bethany)

#1 Can you relate to Mary in your journey with Jesus or are you more easily distracted? What encouraged you in her story to change your focus to Jesus?

#2 What or who is your deepest devotion to? If it is not Jesus, it can only temporarily fulfill your needs. Discuss changes you can make to put Jesus first.
